We also had 4 swimmer set pb's, 11 new club records, a 1st place for our 100m mixed freestyle team of Liz, Fettes, Pamela and Chas and a club record for the mixed medley relay team of Gill, Graham Cragg, Rowie and Colin. Oh and the obligatory Fettes moment..”what, my heat is now??”
