

A small squad of 5 swimmers participated in the All Club Challenge on the 15th and 16th of October at HBF Stadium. The event attracted 189 members (including 2 interstate) from 21 clubs which is down considerably from last year's figures of 271 members from 26 clubs. There were 15 state records set over the course of the weekend.

The team consisted of Jeff, Rowie, Charles, Gill and Colin. We finished 11th on a 166 points, a good result considering the size of the other clubs competing. Claremont won the event with 2225 points, the Handicap trophy went to Mandurah and Geraldton won the top country club.
