Although there were no pb's, there were 6 new age group club records set with Lexie setting two, Heather smashing her own 50m breaststroke record by over 8 seconds and Graham setting 3, which included knocking off Fettes 100m free from 2012 and smashing his own 100m backstroke record by nearly 13 seconds.

Our men's relay team in the 4 x 50m men's medley, Graham, Chas, Andy and Colin set a new club record for the 200-239 Age group, well done team!
