CLUB SWIMMER OF THE YEAR RULES

By-Law: 17	Club Swimmer of the Year Rules

Last Amended: 20/03/2017	Changes to Endurance 1000

PREAMBLE

The Male and Female Club Swimmer of the Year are awarded to the male and female club member who achieves the most points across the following swim categories; Endurance 1000, Club Championships, Open Water Swims, and Pool Competition Swims. This By-law lays out the methodology for the determination of the Male and Female Club Swimmer of the Year.

SWIM CATEGORIES AND POINTS

All events are conducted under Masters Swimming Australia rules. Only Masters Events conducted in WA are eligible. Points scored in relay events are excluded. Some categories (see below) are covered by individual Club By-laws which detail how the event is conducted and how points are awarded.

Due to the differences in the maximum possible points that could be scored in each of the four swim categories it is necessary to equalise the points to avoid one category biasing the end result.

Points received by individual swimmers in the following swim categories will be equalised and adjusted to calculate each swimmers Club Swimmer of the Year points. Second Claim member's points are only counted when they are swimming for and or in an Armadale Masters Swimming Club team.

- 1. Endurance 1000: Endurance 1000 events in WA (By-Law 3)
- 2. **Club Championships:** (By-Law 7)
- 3. Open Water Swimming: Masters Swimming WA Open Water Series (By-Law 4)
- 4. Pool Competition Swimming: Masters Pool Competitions in WA (By-Law 15)

CLUB SWIMMER of the YEAR - POINTS

In each of the four swim categories, the highest points scored by an individual swimmer will be awarded 25 points, the second highest points scored by an individual swimmer will be awarded 24 points, the third highest points scored by an individual swimmer will be awarded 23 points and so on to the twenty fifth highest points scorer who will be awarded 1 point. If there are more than twenty five swimmers in the swim category, the twenty sixth and subsequent swimmers will be awards 1 point.

CLUB SWIMMER OF THE YEAR

To determine the Male and Female Club Swimmer of the Year, points awarded to each swimmer in each swim category are combined to determine the Club Swimmer of the Year. The male and female with the highest combined points score across all four swim categories is the Club Swimmer of The Year.
